The 2009 round of the Community and Cultural Grants closed on the 24th April.

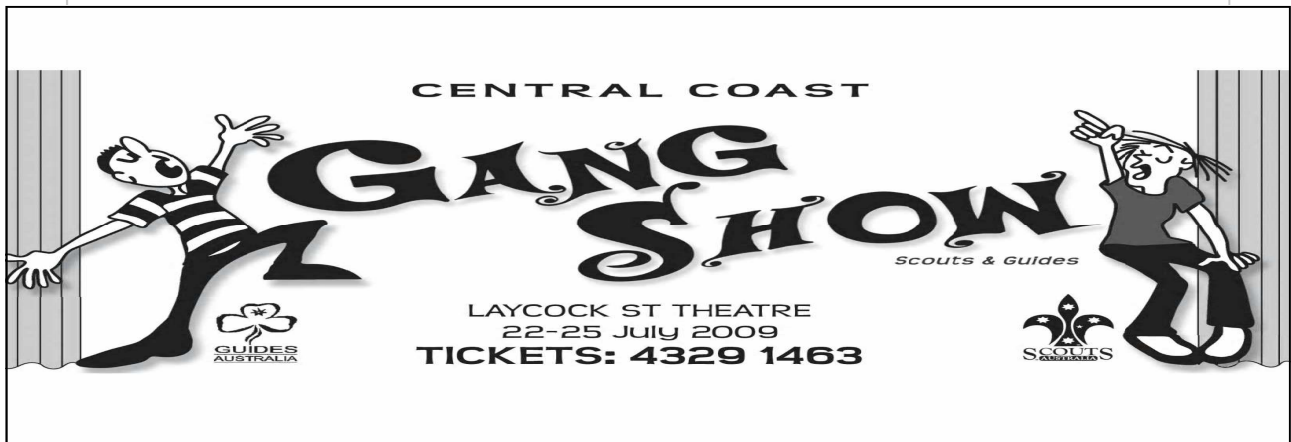
Due to various circumstances, the process of assessment of Council's Community and Cultural grants was held up but announcements will be made as soon as it is finalised.
