ENVIRONMENT AND PLANNING - DEVELOPMENT

POLICY OBJECTIVES

To require applicants, when submitting development applications that exceed Council's height requirements as identified in the relevant Development Control Plan, to erect profiles and/or height poles as directed by Council.

POLICY STATEMENT

No sites will be inspected if there is non-compliance with a Council resolution requiring profiles and/or height poles to be erected.

PROCEDURE

The procedure being an administrative process, may be altered as necessary by the General Manager.

- 1 On the Monday before the Council inspection day, the staff contact the applicant to verify if the profiles and/or poles have been erected.
- 2 All trees to be removed and those to be retained to be flagged according to colour.
