Specialty item that compliments garden.

For the best garden display exhibited on a patio or balcony.
- 11 Best Garden (Nursing Homes/Retirement Villages/
Over 50s Villages)**
Class A -- Maintained by professionals
Class B -- Maintained by residents
- 12 Best Residential Neighbour Gardens**
Best residential neighbouring gardens i.e., a common
garden shared by neighbours in an apartment, villa,
townhouse or streetscape.
