



## 2009 Gosford City Garden Competition Conditions of Entry

1. Entries must be submitted by close of business on Monday, 14 September 2009 by mail to Gosford City Council (Recreation Operations Unit) PO Box 21, Gosford NSW 2250 or by fax (02) 4367 2708.
2. Entries are open to gardens within the Gosford City Local Government Area.
3. The judges' decisions are final and either the judge and/or the organising committee will enter into no correspondence.
4. No entry fee is required.
5. Entrants may compete in as many relevant categories that they like.
6. The *Champion Residential Garden* for Gosford City will be awarded to winners in both Class A and Class B.
7. Points may be deducted should any plants contravene Council's Tree Planting Regulations, as resolved by Gosford City Council on September 22, 1970.
8. Selected prize-winning gardens are to be open to the public between 9am-3pm on Sunday, 11 October 2009, unless otherwise advised. Yourself, or a nominated representative should be onsite on this day.
9. It is the responsibility of the entrant/owner to supply the organising committee with any relevant/ special details.
10. Judges will be looking for water efficiency aspects of the gardens.
